Calling a resident name or number

Calling Guard: press

2 kinds of modes for Calling residents:

Mode 1.: Press → or ← to search the desired resident name then press ok

Mode 2.: Key in resident number directly then press or

Storing resident name and number

Please store resident name (allowed range up to 16 characters) and resident number (the number must be 4 digits) at the same time.

First, open the front cover of PH-855C8, you will find a "PGM" switch which is located at the middle of left side.

Turn on the PGM switch to "ON" position, the screen will display **PROGRAM** FIXED-1 TEXT-3

There are 2 ways to store resident inforantion If you want to store "resident name" & "resident number" in PH-855C8, please choose "TEXT-3". For example, "0001 Mary Church"

Press "3" to access "TEXT-3" mode.

If you want to store "alphabetic string" & "resident number" in PH-855C8, please choose "FIXED-1".

For example, "0001 FLOOR A-20"

Press "1" to access "FIXED-1" mode.

TEXT-3 mode:

Store resident information steps:

- 1 Change? ←→ (OK) Just 2 seconds display
- 2 Change? (0000) Press OK
- 3 Change Name? No(*) Yes(OK) Press OK
- 4 Keys 0 to 9 & → Key in resident name + ok
- 5 Save Name? Press OK, name saved; Press **. clear all letters you key in
- 6 Location?(0000) Key in the number of 4 digits + OK



If you don't want to store resident information, keep this display, just turn off the PGM switch. Finish!

Revise / Delete resident information:

For example, if you have stored 3 resident information already. They were "0001 Mary Chruch", "0002 John Conner" & "0003 Peter Clock". But you want to revise(or delete) the resident information of "0001 Mary Chruch". Please turn on the PGM switch again, you will see the display **PROGRAM** TEXT 1

Revise / Delete resident information:

For example, if you have stored 3 resident information already. They were "0001 FLOOR-21", "0002 FLOOR-22" & "0003 FLOOR-23". But you want to revise(or delete) the resident information of "0001 FLOOR-21". Please turn on the PGM switch again, you will see the display FIXED-1 TEXT-3

Press "1" to "Fixed-1 mode"

Operation

- 1. Call control center(Guard Room): Press 📮
- 2. Call resident: 2 kinds of modes for calling residents, calling time is approx. 5 seconds.

Number Call: key in "resident number" +#

Resident number is allowed to edit from 1-digit to 4-digit.

List Call: Search the resident name you desired by → or ← + OK

3. Calling not existed code(blank code), no message response and appear ← or → Call

Open door operation: PH-855C7/C8 with 500 open door passwords

← or → Call OK → "#" + password +"#" → *OPEN DOOR*

Password is allowed to edit from 1-digit to 12-digit.

Editing open door password

Holding "#" approx. 20 seconds OPEN DOOR CODE? → PASSWORD? → 12345 + OK → Add New Code → X OK

You have accessed to editing mode.

Choose the following menus by → or ←

- --ADD NEW CODES: add new open door password to PH-855C7 / C8
- --EDIT CODES: revise / delete open door password to PH-855C7 / C8
- --VIEW CODES: view open door password in PH-855C7 / C8
- -- CHANGE PASSWORD: change system password not open door password



Change Password


This password is meaning "system password" not "open door password". The original system password in factory is [12345].

Edit codes this function only limits existed password.
